ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED ARE THE FOLLOWING:

-HAZARDOUS WASTE

-METAL

-YARD WASTE

-ASBESTOS

-CEMENT

-ANYTHING OVER 3 FT IN LENGTH

-ASHES

-SLATE SIDING

-ANYTHING IN A LIQUID STATE

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Construction Material - Must be bundled, tied and not to exceed 30 pounds in weight and not to exceed 3 feet in length

Carpet - Must be rolled and tied, not to exceed 3 feet in length

Trash/Garbage - Must be bagged and not to exceed 30 pounds

Paint Cans - must be either cleaned out or dried with lids removed. No cans containing liquid will be accepted

Glass - Any glass, such as window glass must be removed from the frame and placed in a box

Furniture - Items such as chairs, tables, sofa
