In December 2021, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) created the Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) requiring Public Water Systems to develop and submit an inventory of service line materials — both on the private and public side. This was to better protect children and communities from the risks of lead exposure.
