


Village of North Freedom Information Sheet! Quarter 3 2024 - Happy Summer!



Friendly Ordinance Reminders

- THERE SHALL BE NO STORM-WATER,
 SURFACE WATER, GROUNDWATER,
 ROOF RUN-OFF OR SURFACE
 DRAINAGE OR ANY OTHER
 CONNECTIONS FROM INFLOW SOURCES
 TO THE SANITARY SEWER. SUCH
 WATERS MAY ONLY BE DISCHARGED
 TO A STORM SEWER OR OTHER
 WATERWAY WITH PERMISSION OF THE
 VILLAGE BOARD OF NORTH FREEDOM.
 VILLAGE ORDINANCE 13.20
- ALLEY PARKING IS PROHIBITED EXCEPT FOR LOADNIG AND UNLOADING. VILLAGE ORDINANCE 7.04(1)
- "ANY VEHICLE (including trailers**) LEFT UNATTENDED FOR MORE THAN 48 HOURS ON ANY PUBLIC STREET OR GROUNDS, OR ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WHERE PARKING IS PROHIBITED..."
 VILLAGE ORDINANCE 7.06(3)
- NO GRASS CLIPPINGS MAY BE
 DEPOSITED (BLOWN) INTO ANY STREET,
 SIDEWALK, OR ALLEYWAY. THIS HELPS
 PREVENT STORMSEWER CLOGS AND
 THE POLLUTION OF GROUNDWATER.
- NOXIOUS WEEDS, INCLUDING
 VEGETATION, ALL WEEDS, GRASSES &
 PLANTS, MUST BE MAINTAINED AT 11 OR
 BELOW INCHES TO COMPLY WITH
 VILLAGE ORIDINACE 10.03(7).
- GRASS CLIPPINGS/BRUSH/LEAVES ARE
 <u>ONLY</u> COLLECTED BY THE VILLAGE
 DURING THE 2 ALLOTED CLEAN UPS
 PER YEAR. THE NEXT CLEANUP WILL BE
 IN FALL 2024.
- TREES IN THE BOULEVARD/RIGHT OF WAY ARE PROPERTY OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH FREEDOM. THEY MUST NOT BE TRIMMED, REMOVED, CUT, ETC. WITHOUT DISCUSSION WITH THE VILLAGE BOARD.
- TRASH BINS MUST BE PLACED ON THE CURB NOT IN THE STREET NO MORE THAN 24 HOURS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED PICKUP DAY.

Are you retired and finding yourself wanting something to do? The Village of North Freedom is a participant in the Wisconsin Senior Employment Program that is geared towards giving retired or unemployed senior individuals goals of obtaining an income, gaining benefits & new skills, having the feeling of being useful/needed, making new friends, providing structure and a sense of achievement/accomplishment, and lastly being a valuable asset to the community.

Those interested must meet the following requirements: legal resident of WI, 55 years or older, unemployed, a limited income at no more than 125% of the federal poverty level. Individuals would be matched with their personal goals and placed in a position in community service (not-for-profit or government agencies) for approximately 20 hours per week. Participants receive the Wisconsin minimum wage of \$7.25 per hour.
