### **Tax Collection Information**

The Village of North Freedom Village Office (105 N Maple St, North Freedom, WI 53951) will be collecting tax payments during the normal posted Office Hours, however *mailed payments are appreciated* and can be sent to "Village of North Freedom – ATTN: Clerk/Treasurer – PO Box 300, North Freedom, WI 53951" – and you may also use our convenient drop box service located directly underneath the window with the Office Hours of the Village Clerk! We also have an online payment option!

**Dog Licenses -** \*Send a separate check for dog licenses!\*

Dogs 5 months of age or older need to be registered by **April 1** of each year. Information needed for dog tags: Dog Name, Color, Breed, Sex, Vaccine/Vaccine Manufacturer Serial #, Vet Proof of Rabies Vaccination, Date Given & Expiration Date. *Village residents are limited to only <u>2</u> dogs per household – Village Ordinance 12.08(13)*.

- THERE IS NO DOWNTOWN (FROM THE 100 BLOCK OF E WALNUT TO 206 E WALNUT) PARKING FROM 2:00 A.M. TO 6:00 A.M.
- NO GRASS CLIPPINGS MAY BE DEPOSITED (BLOWN) INTO ANY STREET, SIDEWALK, OR ALLEYWAY. THIS HELPS PREVENT STORMSEWER CLOGS AND THE POLLUTION OF GROUNDWATER.
- NOXIOUS WEEDS, INCLUDING VEGETATION, ALL WEEDS, GRASSES & PLANTS, MUST BE MAINTAINED AT 11 OR BELOW INCHES TO COMPLY WITH VILLAGE ORIDINACE 10.03(7).
- SNOW & ICE MUST BE REMOVED TO THE WHOLE WIDTH OF THE SIDEALK WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE CESSATION OF A SNOWSTORM – VILLAGE ORDINANCE 8.04.

# Check for Fire Danger Before Burning!

Check for the daily burning restrictions by either

- Calling 1-888-WIS-BURN (947-2876) from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM daily
- Going online to <a href="https://apps.dnr.wi.gov/wisburn/#/BurnRestrictions">https://apps.dnr.wi.gov/wisburn/#/BurnRestrictions</a>

Sauk County is in a forest fire protection area and a burning permit is required from January 1 through May 31. However, permits are NOT required when the ground is COMPLETELY snow-covered or when a campfire is used for warming or cooking purposes.

## Friends and neighbors,

First a brief update on your Village of North Freedom Board. Two resignations caused the appointment of two new Board Members. Secondly, do you use the village parks? Help us improve it. Many fresh ideas have been brought forward regarding the parks. The Village is applying for a grant to implement the larger, more costly projects, but there are many smaller projects which can be done without hiring outside help or adding them to the DPW's already busy schedule. A village-wide park clean-up day is scheduled for Oct. 12 from 8 a.m. to noon, with a rain date of Oct. 19. With your volunteer help, together we can get some of those small projects done without the use of tax funds. We ask each of you to consider helping. Whether you can spend an hour or all four hours, your help will be appreciated. See more details elsewhere in this newsletter. Come ready to work!

Also, I have been asked by several folks about restoring Freedom Days. For those not familiar with this popular celebration, let me briefly say Freedom Days were a great deal of fun. The celebration can be anything desired if it addresses both adults and children alike. Past Freedom Days have featured carnival rides, a parade, live music, games and more, whatever the North Freedom community wishes. It can be those things mentioned with the addition of more such as a flea market, car show, a run/walk, fireworks, food stands... the list goes on.

In the year 2026 is the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. A large celebration is being planned. It has been suggested that a smaller celebration take place in 2025. The planning stages for both events are underway. The Board is asking residents to step up to help plan and stage these events. A planning meeting is in the works for mid-November to kick off the project. Think about what you would like these celebrations to be and bring those ideas to that meeting. Individuals, businesses, civic groups, church groups, are all welcome to participate. These events will only happen if enough people get involved.

Lastly, VOTE in November. It's your right. It's your privilege. Don't waste it.

On Friday, September 27, 2024, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin approved the North Freedom Municipal Water Utility's request for a "Simplified Rate Increase". This increase was 4.1%. This is your notification of the new rates that will be effective January 1, 2025.
